3. New Business:

a. Litter Pick-up:

d. West Park – there are divot holes, City wants us to help share the cost of fixing that area \$2,600.00/year water – City, we would need to have our landscapers put in the loom, fence it. Estimated cost at \$3,000.00 - \$5,000.00. Would be completed in two separate sections and the fence will be moved to accommodate this.

Conditional on the following: see where the water is spraying and have any obstacles removed in order to ensure the water is covering all spaces; quote comes in under \$5,000.00

e. Remove most benches, leave two City benches and then will put in two picnic type tables (benches with tables). The City is picking up the cost of this \$2,500.00 + installation, approximately \$3,000.00-\$4,000.00.
